In compliance with California's AB506 law, volunteers who work directly with youth must complete child abuse and neglect mandatory reporter training.

Once you have clicked on the course, you can click on 'Open All' to see the 5 parts of this training. It will take about 2 hours to complete step 2. You can claim your time completing this as training hours towards camp training.
